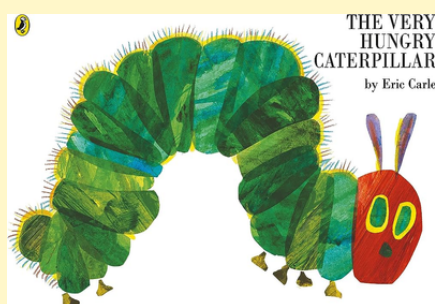

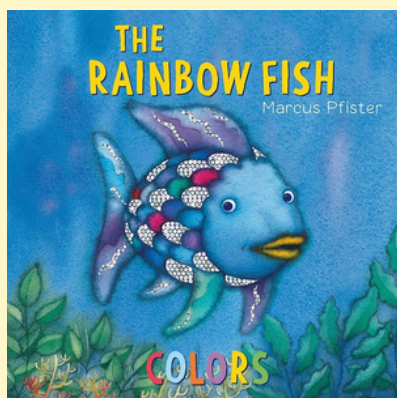

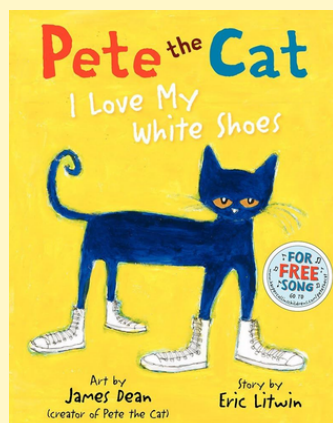

We read the book called “Share my Ice-Cream” and shared the toy ice-cream with each other to learn how to collaborate, share and enjoy giving & receiving.



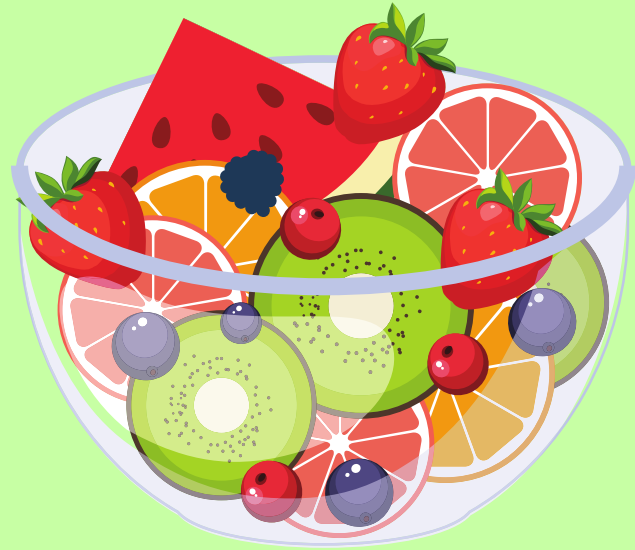
DINOSAUR AT MY DOOR ACTIVITY

FRUIT SALAD

CHILD CENTERED LEARNING WITH MISS ECE

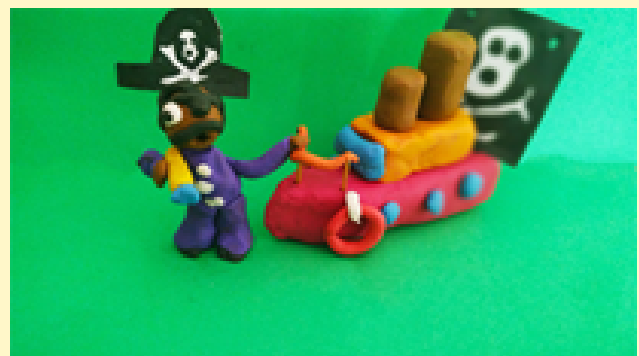
POMPOM ACTIVITY
