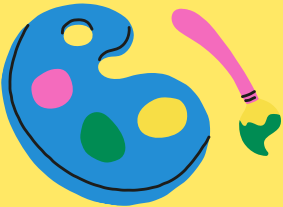

CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIE

- 1/3 cup of sugar
- 3 tablespoons of butter
- 1 egg
- 1 cup of flour
- 1 bag of chocolate chips
- 1 packet of vanilla powder
- 1 packet of baking powder



Mix all the ingredients together in a bowl and put them in small ball shaped pieces onto the oven tray. Bake the cookies at 180 degrees heated oven for 15 min.

Enjoy.

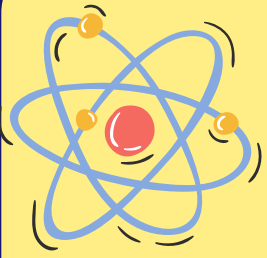
SUGAR COOKIE

We played Halloween math and science games.

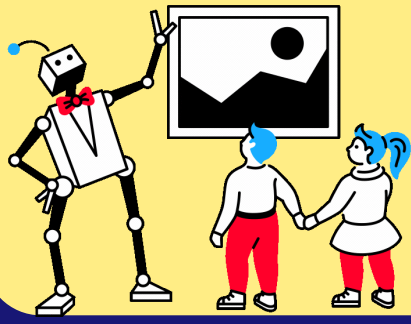

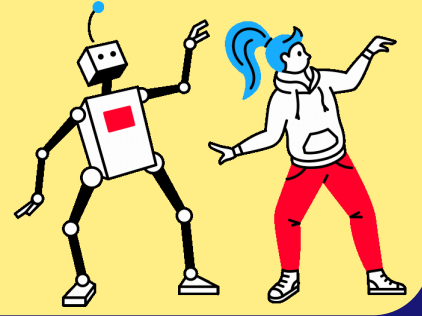

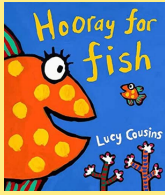

During our rainbow fish activity, the teacher read the book "Hooray for fish", and revised numbers, colors, and sizes. Students then colored and decorated their rainbow fish.

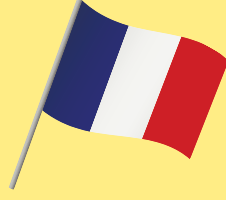
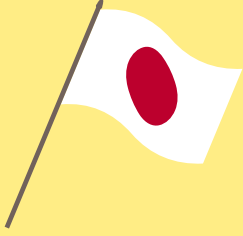


We also went out into the garden to collect fallen leaves which symbolize autumn. We revised seasons in class with a short animation and created our own autumn tree by sticking the dry leaves.
