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CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIE



We also went out into the garden to collect fallen leaves which symbolize autumn. We revised seasons in class with a short animation and created our own autumn tree by sticking the dry leaves.
















In our Around the World activities, students have learned about the countries Japan, France, Mexico, and the USA.

Mr. Michael hid 100 plastic balls of different colors and got the students to collect them in colors. We cleaned all the balls with disinfectant after the game.




NATURE WALK
